We decided in 2007 to plant some Mourvedre, Syrah and Grenache vines in the heart of the Okanagan Valley. In 2009 we harvested the grapes for the icon wine at Red Rooster called the 'Golden Egg'."

A blend of 59% Mourvedre, 24% Syrah and 17% Grenache, the clutch of hens immediately noticed that perfect shade of garnet and a complex, enticing bouquet of Mourvedre (blueberry, vanilla and violet), Syrah (spice), and Grenache (red berries and cherry), and the entrancing note of smoke and oak.
