ABOUT THE WINERY

Red Rooster Winery is located above Okanagan Lake on the Naramata Bench, just north of Penticton. This area is famous for its southwestern exposure and unique microclimate.

Our home is a winery that brings together the craft of winemaking, a love of local (and sometimes offbeat) art and a taste for delicious seasonal food.

ABOUT THE WINE

The grapes for our Chardonnay Reserve 2008 were harvested over two days around the beginning of October. They were whole cluster pressed and then cold settled prior to fermentation and aging for 6 months in new and 1 year old French and American oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Straw yellow colour with a complex bouquet of sweet ripe apple, nut, new oak, biscuit, vanilla bean and a touch of caramel. A medium to full-bodied Chardonnay with a slightly rich, creamy approach which is refreshed moments later by notes of green apple, lemon and smoky oak flavours. A kick of lemony acidity lingers on the finish.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Pair with turkey and a rich mushroom stuffing, baked buttery potatoes, grilled pork chops with Dijon and tarragon, mushroom risotto or creamy pastas with smoked salmon.
