ABOUT THE WINERY

Red Rooster Winery is located above Okanagan Lake on the Naramata Bench, just north of Penticton. This area is famous for its southwestern exposure and unique microclimate.

Our home is a winery that brings together the craft of winemaking, a love of local (and sometimes offbeat) art and a taste for delicious seasonal food.

ABOUT THE WINE

Harvesting of our 2008 Riesling from the Inkameep Vineyard near Oliver took place over two days in late October and early November. The grapes whole cluster pressed to extract aroma and flavour components and cool fermented in stainless steel.

TASTING NOTES

Lemon yellow colour with an aromatic nose of lemon, tangerine, sweet floral, peach and a touch of mineral. The refreshing, vibrant acidity of this light-bodied wine awakens the palate with flavours of juicy orange, sweet apple and tropical fruit flavours. Just off-dry with refreshing citrus, green apple and white peach notes of the finish.

FOOD PAIRINGS

Pair with citrus glazed salmon, light curry dishes, fish and chips, spicy Dungeness crab cakes, summer salads with light vinaigrette or pork loin with sauteéd apples.
