### ABOUT THE WINERY

Red Rooster Winery is located above Okanagan Lake on the Naramata Bench, just north of Penticton. This area is famous for its southwestern exposure and unique microclimate.

Our home is a winery that brings together the craft of winemaking, a love of local (and sometimes offbeat) art and a taste for delicious seasonal foods.

### ABOUT THE WINE

Picked over several days in October, our 2009 Chardonnay is whole cluster pressed to extract aroma and flavour components. For added depth of flavour and complexity, the wine was fermented in French oak barrels, of which 15% were new oak. Production of 1793 cases.

### TASTING NOTES

Bright yellow colour with a delicate nose of apple, toasty oak, yellow plum and pineapple. This medium-bodied Chardonnay, with its flavours of green apple, spice and lemon, makes for a great sipping wine. Spice, butter and biscuit notes linger on the finish. Drink while young and fresh.

### FOOD PAIRINGS

Serve with cheesy chicken wraps; turkey with creamy aioli on crusty rolls; light cream sauces on pasta and seafood; turkey pot pies; creamy crab salads.
